Appendix B: Nomination Dates for By-election of Member of Parliament for Mbale Municipality Constituency, Mbale District

The Electoral Commission has appointed **20th and 21st January 2010**, as nomination dates for the by-election of Member of Parliament for Mbale Municipality Constituency, Mbale District.

The nomination of candidates shall take place at Mbale Municipal Council Hall, beginning at 9.00 a.m. and ending at 5:00pm on each of the appointed dates.

An aspiring candidate for Member of Parliament shall be a citizen of Uganda and a registered voter, and will be required to observe the following:

Nomination shall be made by two (2) registered voters from the constituency, who shall appear in person to the Returning Officer, and present:

- A nomination paper filled in duplicate indicating names, age, address, and occupation of the aspiring candidate,
- Names and address of a person appointed as the official agent;
- A list of names and signatures of ten (10) persons, who must be registered voters in Mbale Municipality Constituency where the person seeks nomination as a candidate;
- A non-refundable nomination fee of Shs. 200,000/- (two hundred thousand shillings only). This money must be in cash or in bankdraft payable to the Uganda Administration;
- Two (2) postcards size copies of a recent straight face, colour photograph with a light background.
- **Certified copies of educational qualifications. a minimum formal education of Advanced Level or its equivalent is required for an aspiring candidate for Member of Parliament.**
- A proof of resignation, in the case of public officers.
- Certified copies (if qualifications were attained outside Uganda) from the National Council of Higher Education.

A candidate who uses a convoy for purposes of nomination shall have a maximum of two vehicles bearing Police stickers and each shall carry a maximum of ten persons.
